REGULATIONS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. VENUE & DATE:

Big Rivers BMX Club. 24 Chambers Drive, Katherine. The event will be held over three days; Pre meet September 30th. Titles Friday 2nd and Saturday 3rd of October.

2. CONSTITUTION OF CLASSES:

This event is open to all BMX riders in Australia that hold a current Open, MTBA/CA upgrade, Sprocket and Mini Wheelers license. Five (5) riders constitute a class. Classes with less than five (5) nominations will be combined rule 6. Year of birth applies to all classes (i.e. the riders age at 31.12.2020).

Riders are not permitted to nominate into a class above their age or other gender at this event rule 5.

3. MOTOS & FINALS:

The Pre-meet will be four (4) motos and no finals.

The BMXNT Titles will consist of four (4) motos followed by extra moto, semi-finals, extra points moto, consolation finals & deadman finals for classes as required. Olympic lane draw in 'deadman' finals rule 18. Finals transfers as per rule 12.1 (a). Class sizes and qualifiers rule 12.3. For classes with less than eight riders, rule 12.2 (a) applies. In the case of a tie, rule 12.4 applies.

Friday night will be all Cruiser, MTB Mini Wheelers and Sprockets classes. Followed by finals and presentation for those classes.

Saturday night will be all 20" classes followed by presentation for those classes.

4. CLASSES:

The following Classes are offered.

8-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-16, 17-24, 25-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50+ Male and Female.

MTB bikes

9-13, 14+ Mountain Bike.

Open Class:

20" bikes

Men (14+), Women (14+).

Team entries

(Perpetual trophies are not be taken out of the NT)

Nominations close with the registrar on Thursday 1st of October at 6 pm.

Corporate team: \$50 entry. Win the prize pool and perpetual trophy.

Club Team: No Charge. Win the perpetual trophy.

Teams are to be made up of four riders with two (2) reserves.

5. ENTRY FEES:

Pre-Titles per rider / per class	\$25.00
Titles Mini Wheelers and Sprockets	\$40.00
Age, Cruiser, Open class and MTB	\$75.00
\$10 transponder rental fee added in the nomination process if a personal transponder is not entered.	
Secondary class (24" cruiser class after nominating in a 20" class)	\$50.00

All profits raised from this event go back into development of BMX in the NT.

6. ENTRY METHODS:

BMXA Website: [Online Event Entry](#)

ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY 10:30 PM (ACST) ON SUNDAY 16TH OF AUGUST 2020.

Late entries may be considered at the discretion of the BMXNT Registrar with a \$20 late fee.

7. CLOSE OF ENTRIES:

The event is pre-entry only through the online nomination process.

Entries must be received by 10:30 pm (ACST) on Sunday 16th of August 2020.

Late entries may be considered at the discretion of the BMXNT Registrar with a \$20 late fee.

8. AWARDS / PLATES:

- Awards for all Mini Wheelers and Sprocket riders.
- Plates and awards to all 20", 24" & MTB class finalists placed 1st to 8th at the titles event.
- Perpetual trophy for the winner and prize pool 1st – 8th of \$1500 for Open Class Men and \$1500 for Open class Women.

(Perpetual trophies are not be taken out of the NT)

9. REGISTRATION:

Riders will register at the event to confirm participation and present a current BMXA licence. Registration times are listed in the schedule.

10. SCRUTINEERING:

Inspections of bikes and safety equipment will be done on a random basis. Participants are required to make sure all equipment is in good condition as per BMXA rules or riders will be excluded from participating until any issues are corrected.

11. NUMBER PLATES & TRANSPONDERS:

BMXNT will allocate race numbers if there are duplicates in a class or more than three digits. Riders with current state, national or world ranking will be allocated those numbers if requested in the nomination process.

BMXNT will be providing plates and numbers for all participants and these must be utilised throughout the duration of all Titles events.

This will be a transponder event. If you have a personal transponder provide the serial number in the nomination process to avoid an additional \$10 rental fee in the first class nomination. Transponders are not required for sprockets or Mini-Wheelers. If the hired transponder is not returned a fee of \$150 will be charged. It is the rider's responsibility to ensure that the transponder is correctly fitted to their bike and functioning correctly. A testing station will be available during registration.

12. ACCEPTANCE:

A list of entrants and Officials will be on the BMXA website [Online Event Entry](#) page.

It is the rider's responsibility to confirm that their entry is correct. No refunds will be given after the 7th of September without a medical certificate. All cancellations after this date will incur a \$20 administration fee.

13. ALCOHOL AND DRUGS:

No alcohol, drugs or cigarettes are to be consumed within the confines of the race track during events. Smoking may be partaken in the allocated areas under NT legislation. Security personnel may remove intoxicated patrons.

All entrants through nomination agree to submit to standard Australian Drug in Sport testing for the use of drugs & alcohol. Random testing may occur.

14. RULES, REGULATIONS & CODES OF CONDUCT:

The event will be run in accordance with the Australian Regional Applications 27/1/2020. A current version is available at www.bmxaustralia.com.au.

Other documents that we abide by are the BMXNT constitution, Regulations & code of conduct, BMXA Member Protection Policy and Social Media Policy. These documents are available on the BMXNT and BMXA web sites.

15. ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING:

The AGM will be held on Thursday 1st of October. There will be two board positions declared vacant. People that are motivated to help promote and develop BMX in the NT are encouraged to speak with their club President or BMXNT Board member to seek more information & a nomination form.
