 - o BMXA rule 019 Olympic lane draw applies, except ties decided by count back 013.4
 - o Classes of 8 riders or less will have four motos
- Mini Wheelers & Sprockets:- four motos
- Acceptance of entry is subject to final approval of organizing committee.

- All riders must hold a Mini Wheeler, Sprocket, 4 Month or Open BMXA license. Club licenses are not accepted.
