Notes:

1. Mandatory transponder ownership for open license riders. Order a transponder online before the closing of entries at www.bmxv.com.au
2. Riders can hire a transponder for \$10 (discount applied and to be returned on the day of the event). Non returned hire transponders to incur \$200 charge.
3. Subject to entries, separate male and female classes will be run except for Novice class.
4. Each bike in these classes require a unique transponder. No sharing transponders between bikes.
5. Not all classes are offered. The riding up rules apply towards the pinnacle age of 24.
6. No refunds unless:
 - a. It is found after the close of entries that a rider's nominated Class is not available and a suitable alternative Class is not available; or
 - b. A rider is injured or becomes ill prior to the event and produces a **medical certificate**, in which case an administration fee will be deducted.
7. It is the rider's responsibility:
 - a. To check if an entry has been received. Entry lists will be progressively updated on the BMXV web site www.bmxv.com.au
 - b. To ensure they register, check Moto sheets, attend staging on time and ride in their correct Moto.
8. Riders who fail to register will not be included in Moto draw.
9. All Invitational finals to be run together before the A finals.

2019 THUNDERDOME ENTRY FORM

Racing:

- THUNDERDOME is a Category S event
- BMXA rules 2019 applies
- Age Determination on 31st December 2019
- At the close of entries, four (4) riders constitute a class
- Format:- Six (6) Moto/final (quarters / semi's as required)
 - Four (4) Motos run on Saturday and two (2) Motos and final on Sunday
 - Racing is conducted over two (2) days, with points through Motos, dead man semis and dead man finals.
 - Invitational finals included (except for Pro Classes)
 - BMXA rule 019 Olympic lane draw applies, except ties decided by countback 013.4.
 - Classes of 8 riders or less will have Seven (7) Motos
- Mini Wheelers & Sprockets:- Seven (7) Motos
- Acceptance of entry is subject to the final approval of the organising committee.
- Novice rules: www.bmxv.com.au
- All riders must hold a mini wheeler, sprocket, 4 months or open BMXA license. Club licenses are not accepted.
- Pro Classes: Please check Moto orders as it may possibly be different from Saturday to Sunday
- Riders who wish to qualify for the Top 8 Shoot-out must enter Superclass or Ebony's Superclass.
- Time Trial top 8 times qualifies for top 8 Shoot-Out.
- King & Queen of Thunderdome Awards goes to the fastest lap time in Motos only.
